This year, the first and second grade advanced/gifted classes have been assigned the country of Colombia for Hispanic Heritage. Students are to complete the projects listed below which will be worth two Social Studies AND two Spanish grades. Please make sure to include all parts of the projects as mentioned in the rubric below.

Instructions:

Brochure: Students are to create a small brochure (by folding regular-sized construction paper into three parts). The cover design must include the name of the country. Inside the brochure each of the following topics must be included: food, music, clothing, and tourist areas. Each topic should include at least three sentences hand-written by student. Typed projects WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Doll: Students must cut, color, and/or decorate the doll pattern provided. Dolls should represent the assigned country, Colombia. Students are encouraged to be as creative as possible by using materials such as yarn, fabric, beads, etc.
